Amends GS 20-97(b) as it applies to the Town of Matthews to provide that the proceeds of the motor vehicle tax up to \$5 may be used for road repair and improvements, and the proceeds from any tax above \$5 and up to \$30 must be used for public mass transit systems and mass transit-related activities. Effective for taxes imposed for taxable years beginning on or after July 1, 2007.

H 1112. ADJUST MATTHEWS MOTOR VEHICLE TAX. Filed 3/27/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 20-97(b) as it applies to the town of Matthews to specify that the proceeds of the motor vehicle tax may be used for road construction, maintenance, and repair, including sidewalks, or for public mass transit systems and mass transit-related activities (previously proposed language allowed the use of the proceeds of the tax rate up to \$5 for road repair and improvements and the proceeds above \$5 and up to \$30 for public mass transit systems and mass transit-related activities). Makes conforming title change.
