Enacts GS 103-11 adopting June 19th as Juneteenth National Freedom Day in North Carolina, to commemorate the ending of slavery in the US.

H 1607. RECOGNIZE JUNETEENTH NATIONAL FREEDOM DAY (NEW). Filed 4/18/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes proposed GS 103-11

adopting June 19th as Juneteenth National Freedom Day and instead provides that when Juneteenth National Freedom Day or a substantially similar holiday becomes a nationally recognized holiday, the General Assembly must recognize June 19th as Juneteenth National Freedom Day. Conforms the title.
