Amends GS 126-4 with respect to the State Personnel Commission, GS 153A-92(a) with respect to county boards of commissioners, and GS 160A-162(a) with respect to city councils to provide that each level of government will accept any accrued vacation or sick leave for employees who transfer from one unit of government to the other (including transfers between units of the same type), to the extent that the vacation was not paid as terminal leave and the sick leave was not included in the employee's retirement as creditable service.

S 1386. GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES PORT BENEFITS. Filed 5/25/10. Senate committee substitute deletes the provisions of the 1st edition and replaces it with AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY ALLOWING EMPLOYEES MOVING BETWEEN STATE, CITY, AND COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO PORT THEIR SICK AND ANNUAL LEAVE. Authorizes the Legislative Research Commission to study allowing the State Personnel Commission to transfer an employee's accrued annual and sick leave from a city or county, and allowing transfers for employees shifting employment between units of local government. Requires consideration of fiscal impacts. Allows an interim report to the 2011 General Assembly and requires a final report to the 2012 session of the General Assembly.
