

3 "A claimant has no adequate remedy at law and shall not be restrained from pursuing any
4 relief available under the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of North
5 Carolina when (i) the actions of any agent or employee of a local government, local school
6 board, or State department or agency within the scope of the agent's or employee's authority or
7 within the course of employment of the employee results in death or injury to person or
8 property, (ii) no waiver of sovereign or governmental immunity is found to apply by a court of
9 competent jurisdiction under any provision of the General Statutes, and (iii) no other claim for
10 relief that would allow the claimant to recover fair compensation is available under State law."
