for the payment of incentives pursuant to an agreement that makes the incentive payments contingent on prior completion of the project or activity, or completion on a specified timetable, and a specified level of job creation or new capital investment.'

SECTION 10.2. This Part becomes effective May 1, 2010, but does not apply to any pending litigation or orders issued by a court of competent jurisdiction prior to that date.
