2	AN ACT TO TREAT ONE APPLICATION BY A UNIFORMED VOTER FOR AN
3	ABSENTEE BALLOT AS AN APPLICATION FOR ALL ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR
4	WHICH THE VOTER WOULD BE ELIGIBLE DURING THE SAME CALENDAR
5	YEAR.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 163-247(3) reads as rewritten:
8	"(3) If a single application from an absentee uniformed voter is received by an
9	election official, it shall be considered a valid absentee ballot request with
10	respect to all general, primary, and runoff elections for federal, State, county,
11	or those municipal offices in which absentee ballots are allowed under the
12	provisions of G.S. 163-302, held through the next two regularly scheduled
13	general elections for federal office. during the calendar year in which the
14	application was received. This subdivision does not apply to a special
15	election not involving the election of candidates, unless that special election
16	is being held on the same day as a general or primary election."
17	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to any
18	applications for absentee ballots received after the November 2010 general election.
