Nondiscrimination. – This section shall be enforced without regard to race, religion, 49 (c)gender, ethnicity, or national origin." 50

1 **SECTION 9.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2012, and applies to bids 2 submitted and contracts entered into on or after that date.
