1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, between lines 31 and 32 by adding new language to read:

3 "f. While serving a subpoena issued by the General Assembly or any committee of
4 the General Assembly authorized to issue a subpoena under the provisions of Chapter 120 of
5 the General Statutes.";

7 And further amends the bill on page 2, between lines 2 and 3 by adding a new section to read:

8 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 120-19.2(d) reads as rewritten:

9 "(d) Any witness shall have five days' notice of hearing, unless waived by the witness,
10 and subpoenas may be served by a member of the General Assembly Special Police, the State
11 Bureau of Investigation, the State Highway Patrol, or within their respective jurisdiction by any
12 sheriff or deputy, or any municipal police officer or other law-enforcement officer. Members of
13 the General Assembly Special Police may serve subpoenas issued under this Chapter anywhere
14 in the State. In addition, a subpoena may be served in the manner provided for service of
15 subpoenas under the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure.";
