1 moves to amend the bill on page 2, line 20, by adding after the word "section." and before the  
2 quote the following:

3 "(d) Exemption. – Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the State, or any  
4 institution, department, or agency of the State that owns or has a legally binding contract in  
5 place for the future purchase of tires having altered or covered sidewalls prior to the date that  
6 this section becomes effective shall perform its existing contractual obligations related thereto  
7 and may continue to use those tires on State vehicles for the useful life of the retreaded tire.";

10 on page 2, line 43, by by adding after the word "section." and before the quote the following:

12 "(d) Exemption. – Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, a local board of  
13 education that owns or has a legally binding contract in place for the future purchase of tires  
14 having altered or covered sidewalls prior to the date that this section becomes effective shall  
15 perform its existing contractual obligations related thereto and may continue to use those tires  
16 on school buses for the useful life of the retreaded tire."
