A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT DIRECTING LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT POLICIES THAT ENCOURAGE HIGH SCHOOL TO WORK PARTNERSHIPS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "§ 115C-47. Powers and duties generally. In addition to the powers and duties designated in G.S. 115C-36, local boards of education shall have the power or duty:			
(34a)	To Encourage High School to Work Partnerships. – Eace ducation shall encourage high schools and local businesses specifically target students who may not seek higher educated high school to work partnerships.
