(2) Practices or attempts to practice irrigation construction or con	tracting by
fraudulent misrepresentation.	
(3) Commits an act of gross malpractice or incompetence as determ	ined by the
Board.	
(4) Has been convicted of or pled guilty or no contest to a crime th	
that the person is unfit or incompetent to practice as an irrigation	
or that indicates that the person has deceived or defrauded the pub	
(5) Has been declared incompetent by a court of competent jurisdiction
