1 moves to amend the bill on page 2, line 50, by decreasing the amount appropriated to the
2 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services by \$100,000 for the 2011-2012 fiscal year
3 and the 2012-2013 fiscal year; and

5 on page 2, line 54, by decreasing the amount appropriated to the Department of Commerce for
6 Commerce State-Aid by \$310,079 for the 2011-2012 fiscal year; and

8 on page 2, line 58, by increasing the amount appropriated to the Department of Environment
9 and Natural Resources by \$410,079 for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and by \$100,000 for the
10 2012-2013 fiscal year; and

12 on page 135, lines 14 and 15, by adding new sections between those lines to read:

13 **"USE OF FUNDS OBTAINED FROM CLOSING THE RALEIGH OFFICE OF THE**
14 **DIVISION OF COASTAL MANAGEMENT**

15 **SECTION 13.10C.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the Department
16 of Environment and Natural Resources shall fund shift General Fund positions, operating
17 expenses, or both to receipt support in the amount of one hundred nine thousand five hundred
18 twenty-three dollars (\$109,523) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the 2012-2013 fiscal year.
19 These federal receipts were formerly used to support the one full-time receipt-supported
20 position that is eliminated as a result of closing the Raleigh Office of the Division of Coastal
21 Management of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources *DN*

22 **FUNDS FOR DENR STUDY OF OIL AND GAS EXPLORATION IN NC**

23 **SECTION 13.10D.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, if House Bill
24 242, 2011 Regular Session becomes law, the Department of Environment and Natural
25 Resources shall use the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) of the nonrecurring
26 funds appropriated to the Department of Commerce for Commerce State-Aid for the Institute of
27 Regenerative Medicine at Wake Forest University ~~Wake~~ for the 2011-2012 fiscal year to study
28 the issue of oil and gas exploration in the State as provided in House Bill 242.

29 **FLEXIBILITY IN REDUCTIONS AT DENR REGIONAL OFFICES**

30 **SECTION 13.10E.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the Department
31 of Environment and Natural Resources shall have the flexibility to determine whether to
32 eliminate vacant or filled match positions or non-match positions, whether to further reduce
33 operating funds, or whether to do any combination of these in order to meet the total reduction

3 **RESTORE CERTAIN POSITIONS AT DENR REGIONAL OFFICES**

4 **SECTION 13.10F.(a)** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the total
5 reduction for eliminating positions at the seven Regional Offices of the Department of
6 Environment and Natural Resources is decreased by four hundred twenty thousand eight
7 hundred seventy-two dollars (\$420,872) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and for the 2012-2013
8 fiscal year, and the following positions shall not be eliminated at the seven Regional Offices:

18 **SECTION 13.10F.(b)** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the
19 Department of Environment shall reduce its costs by the sum of three hundred ten thousand
20 seventy-nine dollars (\$310,079) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year by eliminating vacant positions
21 the Department selects from across the Department, and the Department shall use these funds
22 to decrease the reduction under subsection (a) of this section by the sum of three hundred ten
23 thousand seventy-nine dollars (\$310,079) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year.

24 **DENR CELL PHONE FUNDS REDUCTION**

25 **SECTION 13.10G.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the General
26 Fund recurring reduction for cell phones across the Department of Environment and Natural
27 Resources is increased by the sum of twenty-two thousand four hundred fifty dollars (\$22,450)
28 for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and for the 2012-2013 fiscal year.

29 **DENR MOTOR FLEET MANAGEMENT FUNDS REDUCTION**

30 **SECTION 13.10H.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the General
31 Fund recurring reduction for motor fleet management expenditures across the Department of
32 Environment and Natural Resources is increased by the sum of eighty-eight thousand three
33 hundred forty-three dollars (\$88,343) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and for the 2012-2013 fiscal
34 year."; and

36 on page 137, line 24, by deleting that line and substituting the following to read: "**CHANGES;**
37 **FUNDS TO PROMOTE WATER SUPPLY DEVELOPMENT**"; and

39 on page 139, lines 39 and 40, by adding new subsections between those lines to read:

40 **"SECTION 13.23.(i)** Notwithstanding subsection (h) of this section, if House Bill
41 609, 2011 Regular Session becomes law, the Department of Environment and Natural
42 Resources shall use eighty-three thousand dollars (\$83,000) of funds available to the

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1 Department of Environment and Natural Resources for Water Resources projects for the
2 2011-2012 fiscal year to implement House Bill 609.

3 **SECTION 13.23.(j)** If House Bill 609, 2011 Regular Session becomes law, the
4 Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall use eighty-three thousand dollars
5 (\$83,000) of the funds appropriated under this act to the Department of Environment and
6 Natural Resources for the Green Square Operating Reserve for the 2012-2013 fiscal year to
7 implement House Bill 609."; and

9 on page 176, lines 8 and 9, by adding new sections between those lines to read:

10 **"MUSEUM OF NATURAL SCIENCES TEMPORARY WAGES**

11 **SECTION 13.30.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the reduction in
12 temporary wages for the Museum of Natural Sciences is decreased by the sum of one hundred
13 thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the 2012-2013 fiscal year.

14 **GREEN SQUARE OPERATING RESERVE**

15 **SECTION 13.31.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the recurring
16 appropriation to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources under this act for the
17 Green Square Operating Reserve is decreased by the sum of one hundred thousand dollars
18 (\$100,000) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the 2012-2013 fiscal year.

19 **SOIL AND WATER AREA COORDINATOR POSITIONS AT DENR REGIONAL**
20 **OFFICES**

21 **SECTION 13.32.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the total
22 reduction for eliminating positions at the seven Regional Offices of the Department of
23 Environment and Natural Resources is decreased by three hundred sixty thousand two hundred
24 seventy-eight dollars (\$360,278) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the 2012-2013 fiscal year,
25 and the following Soil and Water Coordinator positions shall not be eliminated at the seven
26 Regional Offices:

34 **SECTION 13.33.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the recurring
35 reduction for the operating expenses for the Division of Forest Resources of the Department of
36 Environment and Natural Resources is increased by the sum of two hundred thousand dollars
37 (\$200,000) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the 2012-2013 fiscal year.

38 **PARKS AND RECREATION OPERATING REDUCTION**

39 **SECTION 13.34.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the recurring
40 reduction for the operating expenses for the Division of Parks and Recreation of the
41 Department of Environment and Natural Resources is increased by the sum of sixty thousand
42 two hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$60,278) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the 2012-2013
43 fiscal year."; and

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On page 119, lines 46 and 47, by adding a new section between those lines to read:

"AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH STATIONS OPERATING REDUCTION


SECTION 11.8. Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, a recurring reduction for the operating expenses of the agricultural research stations of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services is increased by the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the 2012-2013 fiscal year."; and

on page 187, lines 17 and 18, by adding a new subsection between those lines to read:

"SECTION 14.12.(h) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the non-recurring appropriation to the Department of Commerce for Commerce State-Aid for the Institute under this act is decreased by the sum of three hundred ten thousand seventy-nine dollars (\$310,079) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year.";

and by adjusting the appropriate totals accordingly.
