School Calendar Flexibility/Inclement Weather.

Referred to: March 1, 2011 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO GIVE CERTAIN LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION ADDITIONAL 3 FLEXIBILITY WITH REGARD TO INSTRUCTIONAL TIME LOST DUE TO 4 INCLEMENT WEATHER OR OTHER EMERGENCY SITUATIONS. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 **SECTION 1.(a)** G.S. 115C-84.2(a)(1) reads as rewritten: School Calendar. - Each local board of education shall adopt a school calendar 7 "(a) 8 consisting of 215 days all of which shall fall within the fiscal year. A school calendar shall 9 include the following: 10 A minimum of either 180 days and or 1,000 hours of instruction covering at (1)least nine calendar months. The local board shall designate when the 180 11 12 instructional days or 1,000 hours shall occur. The number of instructional 13 hours in an instructional day may vary according to local board policy and does not have to be uniform among the schools in the administrative unit. 14 Local boards may approve school improvement plans that include days with 15 varying amounts of instructional time. If school is closed early due to 16 inclement weather, the day and the scheduled amount of instructional hours 17 18 may count towards the required minimum to the extent allowed by State 19 Board policy. The school calendar shall include a plan for making up days and instructional hours missed when schools are not opened due to 20 21 inclement weather. 22 If, due to inclement weather, a local board of education complies with this subdivision by scheduling 1,000 hours of instruction on less than 180 23 days, the local school administrative unit is deemed to have a minimum of 24 180 days of instruction, teachers employed for a 10-month term are deemed 25 to have been employed for 180 instructional days, and all other employees 26 27 shall be compensated as if they had worked their regularly scheduled hours for 180 instructional days." 28 **SECTION 1.(b)** This section applies only to the following: 29 30 Local school administrative units that missed more than 20 instructional (1)days during the 2010-2011 school year due to inclement weather, provided 31 that instruction is provided at least through June 10. 32 Local school administrative units that missed instructional days at one or 33 (2)34 more schools during the 2010-2011 school year due to the partial or
