6 (a) Members; Selection. – The North Carolina Mining and Energy Commission shall  
7 consist of 16 members appointed as follows:

- 8 (1) The Chair of the North Carolina State University Minerals Research  
9 Laboratory Advisory Committee, or the Chair's designee, nonvoting ex  
10 officio.
- 11 (2) The State Geologist, or the State Geologist's designee, nonvoting ex officio.
- 12 (3) The Assistant Secretary of Energy for the Department of Commerce, or the  
13 Assistant Secretary's designee, nonvoting ex officio.
- 14 (4) The Chair of the Environmental Management Commission, or the Chair's  
15 designee, nonvoting ex officio.
- 16 (5) The Chair of the Commission for Public Health, or the Chair's designee,  
17 nonvoting ex officio.
- 18 (6) One appointed by the Governor who is a representative of the mining  
19 industry.
- 20 (7) One appointed by the Governor who is a representative of the mining  
21 industry.
- 22 (8) One appointed by the Governor with experience in oil and gas exploration,  
23 production, or development.
- 24 (9) One appointed by the Governor who shall be a representative of local  
25 government interests.
- 26 (10) One appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the  
27 President Pro Tempore of the Senate with experience in environmental  
28 conservation or mitigation.
- 29 (11) One appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the  
30 President Pro Tempore of the Senate with experience in oil and gas  
31 exploration, production, or development.

- 1           (12) One appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the  
2           President Pro Tempore of the Senate with interest in mineral, oil, and gas  
3           exploration, production, or development.  
4           (13) One appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the  
5           Speaker of the House of Representatives with experience in environmental  
6           conservation or mitigation.  
7           (14) One appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the  
8           Speaker of the House of Representatives with experience in oil and gas  
9           exploration, production, or development.  
10          (15) One appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the  
11          Speaker of the House of Representatives with interest in mineral, oil, and gas  
12          exploration, production, or development.  
13          (16) One appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the  
14          Legislative Services Commission who shall be a representative of local  
15          government interests.  
16          (b) Terms. – The term of office of members of the Commission is three years. A  
17          member may be reappointed to any number of successive three-year terms. The term of  
18          members appointed under subdivisions (6), (9), (10), and (13) of subsection (a) of this section  
19          shall expire on June 30 of years evenly divisible by three. The terms of members appointed  
20          under subdivisions (7), (11), (14), and (16) of subsection (a) of this section shall expire on June  
21          30 of years that precede by one year those years that are evenly divisible by three. The terms of  
22          members appointed under subdivisions (8), (12), and (15) of subsection (a) of this section shall  
23          expire on June 30 of years that follow by one year those years that are evenly divisible by  
24          three."
