		business ratings, and premiums under Chapter 58 of the General

	<u>c.</u>	The Department of Commerce, Division of Employment Security		
		(DES), shall release to GBICC, or otherwise provide access to, all		
		data requested by GBICC relating to unemployment insurance		
		coverage, claims, and business reporting under Chapter 96 of the

2		provide access to, all data requested by GBICC relating to safety
3		inspections, wage and hour complaints, and enforcement activities

5	<u>e.</u>	The Department of Revenue shall release to GBICC, or otherwise
6		provide access to, all data requested by GBICC relating to the
7		registration and address information of active businesses, business
8		tax reporting, and aggregate federal tax Form 1099 data for
9		comparison with information from DES, the Rate Bureau, and the
10		Department of the Secretary of State for the evaluation of business
