- (a) The North Carolina Board of Dietetics/Nutrition is created. The Board shall consist of seven-five members as follows:
  - (1) One member shall be a professional whose primary practice is clinical dietetics/nutrition;
  - One member shall be a professional whose primary practice is community or public health dietetics/nutrition; dietetics/nutrition, or an educator on the faculty of a college or university specializing in the field of dietetics/nutrition;
