Moore moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 5 by rewriting those lines to read: "TO COMPLY WITH THE PROGRAM OR ITS RULES, AND TO MAKE OTHER CHANGES TO THE REPORTING REQUIREMENT FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE OFFENSES.": and on page 2 lines 6 by rewriting those lines to read: "SECTION 2. Section 3 of S.L. 2012-39 reads as rewritten: 'SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2012,2012. and Section 1 of this act applies to defendants placed on probation on or after that date.
