7 2. Actual knowledge that such conduct was injurious to
8 consumers.

9 3. Reason to know there is a reasonable probability of injury to
10 consumers.

11 b. The conduct constituting the violation was not required by
12 regulations, orders, rules, or other pronouncement of, or any statute
13 administered by, a federal, State, or local government agency.";

15 and on page 2, lines 19-22, by rewriting those lines to read:

17 "(2) The claim is based on knowing and willful conduct applicable to the
18 manufacturing, marketing, distribution, advertising, labeling, or sale of food,
19 and the claimed injury was proximately caused by such violation."
