moves to amend the bill on page 109, by deleting lines 1-15 and substituting the following:

Eligibility. - The Department of Health and Human "SECTION 12B.1.(a) Services, Division of Child Development and Early Education, shall continue implementing the prekindergarten program (NC Pre-K). The NC Pre-K program shall serve children who are four years of age on or before August 31 of the program year. In determining eligibility, the Division shall establish income eligibility requirements for the program not to exceed seventyfive percent (75%) of the State median income. Up to twenty percent (20%) of children enrolled may have family incomes in excess of seventy-five percent (75%) of median income if those children have other designated risk factors. In addition, any age-eligible child who has any of the following characteristics shall be eligible for the program: (i) a child of an active duty member of the Armed Forces of the United States, including the North Carolina National Guard, State military forces, or a reserve component of the Armed Forces, who was ordered to active duty by the proper authority within the last 18 months or is expected to be ordered within the next 18 months, (ii) a child of a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, including the North Carolina National Guard, State military forces, or a reserve component of the Armed Forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty, (iii) a child with Limited English Proficient (LEP) as indicated by the family and/or child speaking limited or no English in the home; (iv) a child with an identified disability as indicated by the child having a current Individualized Education Plan (IEP); (v) a child who has been determined "at-risk" by DCDEE based upon documentation that the child's eligibility criteria and other factors constitute a significant and substantial risk that the child would be unable to avail himself/herself of the opportunity to obtain a sound basic education. Eligibility determinations for prekindergarten participants may continue through local education agencies and local North Carolina Partnership for Children, Inc., partnerships.".
