10	that are geographically diverse. The local NC Pre-K administrator shall contract with the	
11	provider for operation of a classroom established pursuant to the pilot program. The Division	
12	shall provide a report on the status of the pilot program to the Joint Legislative Oversight	
13	Committee on Health and Human Services and the Fiscal Research Division no later than	
14	January 31, 2014. The report shall include the following:
