6	"§ 115C-210.4.	Duties of the Council.			
7	It shall be the	duty of the Advisory Council:			
8	(1)	To advise the State Board of Education on ways to meet more effectively the			
9		educational needs of Indian students; To review annually relevant data on			
10		American Indian students using reports made available to the Council by the			
11		Department of Public Instruction. The review shall include, but not be			
12		limited to, data on academic performance, growth, suspension and expulsion			
13		events, dropouts, and graduation rates.			
14	(2)	To advocate <u>for</u> meaningful programs to reduce and eventually eliminate			
15		low achievement and concurrent high attrition rates among American Indian			
16		students;students.			
17	<u>(2a)</u>	To prepare an annual report that includes an action plan and make an annual			
18		presentation to the State Board of Education to advise the State Board on			
19		ways to meet the educational needs of American Indian students more			
20		effectively based on the State Board's strategies, policies, and information.			
21	(3)	To prepare an annual present and share the annual report on a fiscal year			
22		basis on the status of Indian education, said report to be presented to the			
23		State Board of Education and to the various Indian tribal organizations with			
24		the Indian Tribes and Indian organizations referenced in Article 71A of the			
25		General Statutes and organizations holding membership on the North			
26		Carolina State Commission of Indian Affairs pursuant to G.S. 143B-407 at			
27		the statewide Indian Unity Conference; Conference and with the North			
28		Carolina State Commission of Indian Affairs, along with an action plan			
29		based on recommendations.			
30	(4)	To work closely with the Division of Indian Education in the Department of			
31		Public Instruction, Tribal Leaders, and Title VII Coordinators to
