"PERMIT NOTICE REQUIREMENTS; (7) AMEND DIRECTION TO THE MINING ENERGY COMMISSION CONCERNING ADOPTION OF RULES GOVERNING DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION PERTAINING TO HYDRAULIC FRACTURING FLUID CHEMICALS AND CONSTITUENTS; (8) EXEMPT THE MINING AND ENERGY COMMISSION,"; AND

on page 6, line 24, through page 7, line 37,

by rewriting those lines to read:

"PART VII. AMEND DIRECTION TO THE MINING AND ENERGY COMMISSION CONCERNING ADOPTION OF RULES GOVERNING DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION PERTAINING TO HYDRAULIC FRACTURING FLUID CHEMICALS AND CONSTITUENTS

SECTION 7.(a) G.S. 113-391(a)(5)h. reads as rewritten:

"§ 113-391. Jurisdiction and authority; rules and orders.

h. Disclosure of chemicals and constituents used in oil and gas exploration, drilling, and production, including hydraulic fracturing fluids, to State regulatory agencies and to local government emergency response officials, and, with the exception of those items constituting trade secrets, as defined in G.S. 66-152(3), and that are designated as confidential or as a trade secret under G.S. 132-1.2, requirements for disclosure of those chemicals and constituents to the public. The rules shall provide that the Commission and the Department may review, but shall not possess or take ownership of, data and information related to chemicals and constituents used in hydraulic fracturing fluids that is designated as a trade secret. In addition, for that information related to chemicals and constituents used in hydraulic fracturing fluids that is designated as a trade secret.
