4 "AN ACT TO (1) AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND 5 NATURAL RESOURCES TO ISSUE PERMITS ON OR AFTER MARCH 1, 2015, FOR 6 OIL AND GAS EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES IN THE STATE. 7 INCLUDING THE USE OF HORIZONTAL DRILLING AND HYDRAULIC 8 FRACTURING TREATMENTS FOR THAT PURPOSE; (2) DIRECT THE MINING 9 COMMISSION STUDY AND ENERGY TO DEVELOPMENT OF Α 10 COMPREHENSIVE **ENVIRONMENTAL** PERMIT FOR OIL AND GAS 11 EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES USING HORIZONTAL 12 DRILLING AND HYDRAULIC FRACTURING TREATMENTS; (3) MODIFY 13 PROVISIONS IN THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION ACT CONCERNING THE 14 MINING AND ENERGY COMMISSION'S AUTHORITY TO SET "ALLOWABLES"; 15 (4) PROVIDE A TAX FOR THE SEVERANCE OF ENERGY MINERALS FROM THE 16 SOIL OR WATER OF THE STATE, REPEAL OUTDATED OIL AND GAS TAX STATUTES, AND AUTHORIZE THE SUSPENSION OF PERMITS FOR FAILURE TO 17 18 FILE A RETURN FOR SEVERANCE TAXES; (5) APPROPRIATE MONIES FROM 19 THE MINERAL INTEREST FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT 20 AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO OPERATE THE MINING AND ENERGY 21 COMMISSION AND FOR RELATED EXPENDITURES: (6) ASSIGN FUTURE 22 REVENUE FROM ENERGY EXPLORATION, DEVELOPMENT, AND PRODUCTION 23 OF ENERGY RESOURCES IN ORDER TO PROTECT AND PRESERVE THE STATE'S 24 NATURAL RESOURCES, CULTURAL HERITAGE, AND QUALITY OF LIFE; (7) 25 ENCOURAGE THE GOVERNOR TO DEVELOP THE REGIONAL INTERSTATE 26 OFFSHORE ENERGY POLICY COMPACT; (8) AMEND THE ENERGY POLICY ACT 27 OF 1975 AND THE ENERGY POLICY COUNCIL; AND (9) DIRECT THE MEDICAL 28 CARE COMMISSION TO ADOPT RULES AUTHORIZING FACILITIES LICENSED 29 BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO USE 30 COMPRESSED NATURAL GAS AS AN EMERGENCY FUEL."
