moves to amend the bill on page 18, line 11, through page 19, line 49, by deleting the lines and
substituting the following:

3 "SECTION 7.1.(a) The Revenue Laws Study Committee is directed to study the 4 fiscal impact of its legislative recommendation to the 2014 Regular Session of the 2013 5 General Assembly regarding retailer-contractors. The study shall include a review of the 6 following information:

- 1. The percent of total sales of home improvement that are installed as real property.
- 2. The percent of sales that are currently made at the retail level that would now be taxed at the wholesale amount.
- 10 3. The average difference between the retail price and wholesale price.

11 SECTION 7.1.(b) Notwithstanding G.S. 105-259, the Department of Revenue is 12 directed to provide information to the Fiscal Research Division of the General Assembly to 13 assist with the study under this section.

14 **SECTION 7.1.(c)** This section is effective when it becomes law and expires 15 January 1, 2016.".
