- 2 by adding at the end of the line the following new section:

4 **SECTION 11.14.(a)** Creation. – There is created the Study Committee on The 5 University of North Carolina Tuition. The Committee shall consist of 17 members to be 6 appointed as follows:

- (1) Five members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
 - (2) Five members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
 - (3) Five members of the Board of Governors, appointed by a vote of the Board of Governors.
- (4) Two chancellors of constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina, except that neither may be the Chancellor of the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics or the University of North Carolina School of the Arts.

SECTION 11.14.(b) Co-chairs; vacancies; staff.--The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall designate one representative as cochair, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall designate one senator as cochair. Vacancies on the Committee shall be filled by the same appointing authority making the initial appointment. The Committee, while in the discharge of its official duties, may exercise all powers provided for under G.S. 120-19 and G.S. 120-19.1 through G.S. 120-19.4. The Committee may meet at any time upon the joint call of the cochairs.

The Legislative Services Commission, through the Legislative Services Officer, shall assign professional staff to assist the Committee in its work. The House of Representatives and the Senate's Directors of Legislative Assistants shall assign clerical staff to the Committee, and the expenses relating to the clerical employees shall be borne by the Committee.

28 Members of the Committee shall receive subsistence and travel expenses at the rates set 29 forth in G.S. 120-3.1, G.S. 138-5, or G.S. 138-6, as appropriate.

30 SECTION 11.14(c) Duties. – At a minimum, the Committee shall study the 31 following and shall make recommendations to stem the rise in tuition or to otherwise increase 32 the affordability of higher education for North Carolina residents:

16	Assembly, whichever is earlier.
