- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 70, lines 28-29 by inserting between those lines the following:
- 2 **"SCHOLARSHIP LOANS/FORMER TEACHER ASSISTANTS**
- 3       **SECTION 11.13A.(a)** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 116-209.45 or any
- 4 other provision of law, when awarding scholarship loans under G.S. 116-209.45, the State
- 5 Education Assistance Authority shall give priority to any applicant who qualifies for a
- 6 scholarship loan under G.S. 116-209.45 if the applicant was formerly employed as a teacher
- 7 assistant at a public school in North Carolina but lost his or her teacher assistant position in the
- 8 State public school system as a result of a reduction in force.
- 9       **SECTION 11.13A.(b)** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the sum of
- 10 five million dollars (\$5,000,000) in recurring funds appropriated in this act to the North Carolina
- 11 Need-based Scholarship Program for the 2014-2015 fiscal year shall not be used to support
- 12 financial aid for students attending private colleges and universities but shall instead be used to
- 13 provide scholarship loans to applicants formerly employed as teacher assistants as described under
- 14 subsection (a) of this section for the 2014-2015 fiscal year."
