10 **"SECTION 9.** The Chief Justice's Actual Innocence Commission was established
11 by Order of the North Carolina Supreme Court in Conference. Its primary purpose was to make
12 recommendations that would reduce or eliminate the possibility of the wrongful conviction of
13 an innocent person. In 2006, the General Assembly enacted S.L. 2006-184 that established the
14 North Carolina Innocence Inquiry Commission, as recommended by the Chief Justice's Actual
15 Innocence Commission. Inasmuch as it appears that the work of the Chief Justice's Actual
16 Innocence Commission is complete, the Chief Justice and the North Carolina Supreme Court
17 are encouraged to take appropriate action to formally abolish the Commission."
