"MORATORIUM ON SPECIAL CARE UNIT LICENSES

SECTION 14.1. Section 12G.1(a) of S.L. 2013-360 reads as rewritten:

5 "SECTION 12G.1.(a) For the period beginning July 31, 2013, and ending July 1, 6 2016, July 1, 2015, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health Service 7 Regulation (Department), shall not issue any licenses for special care units as defined in 8 G.S. 131D-4.6 and G.S. 131E-114. This prohibition shall not restrict the Department from 9 doing any of the following:

(1)	Issuing a license to a	facility that is	acquiring an e	existing special care	unit.

- 11 (2) Issuing a license for a special care unit in any area of the State upon a
 12 determination by the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human
 13 Services that increased access to this type of care is necessary in that area
 14 during the three-yeartwo-year moratorium imposed by this section.
 15 (3) Processing all completed applications for special care unit licenses received
 - (3) Processing all completed applications for special care unit licenses received by the Division of Health Service Regulation along with the applicable license fee prior to June 1, 2013.
 - (4) <u>Issuing a license to a facility that was in possession of a certificate of need as of July 31, 2013, that included authorization to operate special care unit beds.</u>"".
