6	SE	<b>CTION 1.</b> G.S. 14-415.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:	
7	" <u>(f)</u> <u>Th</u>	is section does not apply to, there is no disentitlement under this section for, and	
8	the firearms rights as defined in G.S. 14-415.4 are restored to any person who satisfies all of the		
9	following criteria:		
10	<u>(1)</u>	The person's firearms rights were restored prior to December 1, 1995, and	
11		the forfeiture of the person's firearms rights on December 1, 1995, occurred	
12		only because amendments to G.S. 14-415.1, enacted by S.L. 1995-487 and	
13		further amended by S.L. 2004-186, and applicable to any person convicted	
14		of a felony before December 1, 1995, became effective.	
15	<u>(2)</u>	The person's felony convictions prior to December 1, 1995, are only for	
16		nonviolent felonies as defined in G.S. 14-415.4.	

- The person has not been convicted of any subsequent felony on or after 17 (3) December 1, 1995, that would require forfeiture of the person's firearms 18 rights and cause the person to be disentitled under this section." 19 20
  - **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2015.
