Social security numbers and other personal identifying information. 8 9 (f) Any person has the right to request that a register of deeds or clerk of court remove, 10 from an image or copy of an official record placed on a register of deeds' or court's Internet Website available to the general public or an Internet Web site available to the general public 11 12 used by a register of deeds or court to display public records by the register of deeds or clerk of court, the person's social security, employer taxpayer identification, drivers license, state 13 14 identification, passport, checking account, savings account, credit card, or debit card number, or personal identification (PIN) code or passwords contained in that official record. personal 15 identifying information as described in this subsection. The request must be made in writing, 16 legibly signed by the requester, and delivered by mail, facsimile, or electronic transmission, or 17 18 delivered in person to the register of deeds or clerk of court. The request must specify the 19 personal information to be redacted, information that identifies the document that contains the 20 personal information and unique information that identifies the location within the document 21 that contains the social security, employer taxpayer identification, drivers license, state 22 identification, passport, checking account, savings account, credit card, or debit card number, 23 or personal identification (PIN) code or passwords personal identifying information, as described in this subsection, to be redacted. The request for redaction shall be considered a 24 25 public record with access restricted to the register of deeds, the clerk of court, their staff, or 26 upon order of the court. The register of deeds or clerk of court shall have no duty to inquire beyond the written request to verify the identity of a person requesting redaction and shall have 27 no duty to remove redaction for any reason upon subsequent request by an individual or by 28 29 order of the court, if impossible to do so. No fee will be charged for the redaction pursuant to 30 such request. Any person who requests a redaction without proper authority to do so shall be guilty of an infraction, punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for 31 32 each violation. Except as prohibited by some other provision of law: 33 (1) The register of deeds or clerk of court shall, upon receipt of a request made
