"SECTION 3.5. G.S. 115C-218.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: As part of the application review process, the State Board of Education and the "(d) North Carolina Charter Schools Advisory Board shall evaluate charter school applications for approval or rejection based upon the content and substance of the applications. Format issues with an application shall not impact the substantive review of the content of an application. The State Board of Education and the Advisory Board shall provide timely notification to an applicant of any format issues or incomplete information regarding the application and provide the applicant at least five business days to correct those issues in the application. The Advisory

Board shall permit an applicant to address the Advisory Board regarding the application for at 12 least 10 minutes immediately prior to any final vote on an application.""; and
