(Public) Sponsors: Referred to: April 14, 2015 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE WRITTEN NOTICE OF AUTOMATIC CONTRACT RENEWAL 3 FIFTEEN TO THIRTY DAYS PRIOR TO THE AUTOMATIC RENEWAL. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 75-41 reads as rewritten: 6 "§ 75-41. Contracts with automatic renewal clauses. 7 Any person, firm, or corporation person engaged in commerce that sells, leases, or (a) 8 offers to sell or lease, any products or services to a consumer pursuant to a contract, where the 9 contract automatically renews unless the consumer cancels the contract, shall do all of the 10 following: 11 (1)disclose Disclose the automatic renewal clause clearly and conspicuously in 12 the contract or contract offer. 13 Any person, firm, or corporation engaged in commerce that sells, leases, or offers to (b) 14 sell or lease, any products or services to a consumer pursuant to a contract, where the contract automatically renews unless the consumer cancels the contract, shall disclose 15 Disclose clearly and conspicuously how to cancel the contract in the initial 16 (2)contract, contract offer, or with delivery of products or services. 17 For any automatic renewal exceeding 30 days, provide written notice to the 18 (3) consumer by personal delivery, electronic mail, or first-class mail, at least 15 19 20 days but no earlier than 30 days before the date the contract is to be automatically renewed, stating the date on which the contract is scheduled to 21 automatically renew and notifying the consumer that the contract will 22 23 automatically renew unless it is cancelled by the consumer prior to that date. A person, firm, or corporation Person that fails to comply with the requirements of 24 (c) 25 this section is in violation of this section unless the person, firm, or corporation person 26 demonstrates that all of the following are its routine business practice: 27 (1)It The person has established and implemented written procedures to comply 28 with this section and enforces compliance with the procedures. 29 Any failure to comply with this section is the result of error. (2)30 Where an error has caused the failure to comply with this section, it-the (3)person provides a full refund or credit for all amounts billed to or paid by the 31 32 consumer from the date of the renewal until the date of the termination of the 33 contract, or the date of the subsequent notice of renewal, whichever occurs 34 first. 35 This section does not apply to insurers licensed under Chapter 58 of the General (d) 36 Statutes, or to banks, trust companies, savings and loan associations, savings banks, or credit



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1	unions licensed or organized under the laws of any state or the United States, or any foreign
2	bank maintaining a branch or agency licensed under the laws of the United States, or any
3	subsidiary or affiliate thereof. thereof, nor does this section apply to any entity subject to
4	regulation by the Federal Communications Commission under Title 47 of the United States
5	Code or by the North Carolina Utilities Commission under Chapter 62 of the General Statutes,
6	or to any entity doing business directly or through an affiliate pursuant to a franchise, license,
7	certificate, or other authorization issued by a political subdivision of the State or an agency
8	thereof.
9	(e) A violation of this section renders the automatic renewal clause void and
10	unenforceable."
11	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to contracts

12 entered into on or after that date.
