**SECTION 3.** The Department of Public Instruction, in collaboration with the Department of Transportation, shall study procedures that may be employed, and equipment that may be utilized, to increase the safety of children boarding and exiting school buses. Included within this study shall be the feasibility and cost of extending the metal arm in which the mechanical stop signal is affixed or equipping school buses with a metal bar or other device that can extend from the school bus to provide a barrier between children boarding or exiting the school bus and motor vehicles that may be approaching. The Department of Public Instruction shall report its findings and recommendations, including any legislative proposals, to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by January 15, 2016.

**SECTION 4.** Section 1 of this act becomes effective October 1, 2015, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law and the instruction required by G.S. 115C-242(b), as enacted by Section 2 this act, shall be provided beginning with the 2015-2016 school year.

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
