#### Representative Farmer-Butterfield

moves to amend the bill on page 121, lines 34-35, by inserting between those lines a new section to read as follows:

#### "TARGETED CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES PILOT PROGRAM

**SECTION 12F.10.(a)** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, of the funds appropriated in this act to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Information Resource Management (1122,1123), for the 2015-2016 fiscal year to increase funding to address a structural budget deficit within the Division of Information Resource Management, the sum of two million one hundred thousand dollars (\$2,100,000) in nonrecurring funds shall be allocated to the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services, to be used to fund a pilot program that will provide targeted case management services as provided in subsection (b) of this section.

**SECTION 12F.10.(b)** The Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services, shall establish a pilot program that will provide targeted case management services to adults with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities who are on the waiting list for the Innovations waiver. For purposes of the pilot program, targeted case management services shall meet the definition and criteria established in DMA Clinical Coverage Policy 8N that was in effect July 1, 2005 through March 31, 2013. Specifically, targeted case management services are defined as follows: "Case management (I/DD TCM) is an activity that assists recipients to gain access to necessary care: medical, behavioral, social, educational and other services appropriate to their needs. Case management is individualized, person centered, empowering, comprehensive, strengths-based, and outcome-focused. The functions of case management include: (i) case management assessment; (ii) person centered planning; (iii) referral/linkage; and (iv) monitoring/follow-up."

**SECTION 12F.10.(c)** The Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services, shall establish outcome measures to evaluate the impact of the pilot program on the individuals served. The evaluation shall include a comparison of the impact and cost of the targeted case management services to the care coordination services provided to persons who are receiving services through the Medicaid Innovations waiver program. The Department shall report the findings of the pilot program, including any recommendations for further implementation, no later than December 1, 2017, to the Joint
