Representative Ross

moves to amend the bill on page 57, lines 39-40, by inserting between those lines a new section to read:

"FINANCIAL LITERACY PILOT PROGRAM

SECTION 8.31.(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the funds appropriated under this act to the Department of Public Instruction for the 2015-2016 fiscal year shall be increased by the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) in nonrecurring funds to establish and administer a one-year pilot program on teaching financial literacy as a part of the American History, Economics Module curriculum in public high schools. The purpose of the pilot program is to ensure that teachers feel qualified to teach the components of personal financial literacy that are covered in the curriculum and that students are mastering the material. These funds shall be used to provide professional development on teaching financial literacy to teachers in the local school administrative units participating in the pilot and to administer an assessment to students receiving the instruction in those units.

SECTION 8.31.(b) The State Board of Education shall issue an Request for Proposal (RFP) for an approved professional development course and select at least one provider to be used by the pilot local school administrative units. The RFP shall include at least the following criteria:

- (1) Curriculum and resources must be aligned to State standards.
- (2) Professional development must include content and pedagogy training.
- (3) An assessment tool for the course to be provided to local school administrative units at no additional cost to the units.
- (4) Opportunity for either in person training or blended online and in person training with more than seventy-five percent (75%) of the training being in person.
- (5) The course shall be accessible to a minimum of 125 teachers for no more than seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000).

SECTION 8.31.(c) The Department of Public Instruction shall develop a survey to pilot local school administrative units. The survey shall address at least the following items:

- (1) The name of the professional development course taken by the teacher.
- (2) The amount of instruction provided to the teacher and the percentage of in person and online instruction.
