Representative C. Graham

1 moves to amend the bill on page 90, lines 19-20,

- 2 by inserting between those lines the following:
- 3 "UNC-PEMBROKE BORDER TUITION POLICY
  - SECTION 11.20.(a) G.S. 116-144 reads as rewritten:
  - "§ 116-144. Higher tuition to be charged nonresidents.nonresidents; discounted tuition for certain nonresidents.
- 7 (a) The Board of Governors shall fix the tuition and required fees charged nonresidents 8 of North Carolina who attend the institutions enumerated in G.S. 116-4 at rates higher than the 9 rates charged residents of North Carolina and comparable to the rates charged nonresident 10 students by comparable public institutions nationwide, except that a except as provided 11 otherwise by this section.
- 12 (b) <u>A</u> person who serves as a graduate teaching assistant or graduate research assistant 13 or in a similar instructional or research assignment and is at the same time enrolled as a 14 graduate student in the same institution may, in the discretion of the Board of Governors, be 15 charged a lower rate fixed by the Board, provided the rate is not lower than the North Carolina 16 resident rate.
- (c) The Board of Governors may, in its discretion, fix a lower tuition rate for a person
  who is a nonresident of North Carolina who enrolls as an undergraduate at the University of
  North Carolina at Pembroke, provided the rate is not lower than the North Carolina resident
  rate, and the person satisfies all of the following criteria:

- (1) The person resides in a county that is adjacent to the border of North Carolina.

- (2) <u>The person resides within a certain distance of the University of North</u> Carolina at Pembroke, as determined by the Board of Governors."

25 SECTION 11.20.(b) Subsection (a) of this section applies to a person enrolling in
 26 the 2016-2017 academic year.

SECTION 11.20.(c) The Chancellor of the University of North Carolina at Pembroke shall report to the 2017 General Assembly upon its convening regarding the number of students that enrolled under a reduced rate pursuant to G.S. 116-144, as amended by subsection (a) of this section.

31 SECTION 11.20.(d) Subsections (a), (b), and (c) of this section expire June 30, 32 2017.

1	<b>SECTION 11.20.(e)</b> Of the funds appropriated by this act to the Board of		
2	Governors of The University of North Carolina for the 2016-2017 fiscal year the sum of two		
3	hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) in nonrecurring funds shall be allocated to the		
4	University of North Carolina at Pembroke to establish a pilot project at UNC-Pembroke to offer		
5	reduced tuition rates to non-resident students that reside in a county bordering North Carolina		
6	and meet certain other established criteria in accordance with G.S. 116-144, as amended by		
7	subsection (a) of this section.		
8	SECTION 11.20.(f) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the		
9	management flexibility reduction mandated for The University of North Carolina operating		
10	budget for the 2016-2017 fiscal year shall be increased by two hundred fifty thousand dollars		
11	(\$250,000) in nonrecurring funds."; and
