## **"FUNDS FOR TEXTBOOKS AND DIGITAL RESOURCES**

SECTION 8.44. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the total amount of expansion funds available to the Department of Public Instruction in Section 2.1 of this act for textbooks and digital resources shall be seventy million eighty-two thousand five hundred seventy-six dollars (\$70,082,576) for the 2015-2016 fiscal year and seventy million nine hundred fifty-eight thousand four hundred twenty-one dollars (\$70,958,421) for the 2016-2017 fiscal year.".
