1 moves to amend the bill on page 8, lines 42-43  
2 by inserting the following between those lines:

3 "SECTION 10.5. The Department of Public Safety, in consultation with the Office  
4 of Information Technology Services and the Federal Bureau of Investigation, shall study the  
5 development of a system to allow a background check to be conducted in private transfers of  
6 firearms. The study shall consider methods that would allow the ~~the~~ seller or transferor to  
7 access the Criminal Justice Law Enforcement Automated Data Services (CJLEADS), the  
8 National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS), or another similar system that  
9 would provide information to the seller or transferor regarding the purchaser or transferee's  
10 eligibility to purchase a pistol.

11 The Department shall report its findings and any recommended legislation to the Joint  
12 Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety on or before January 1, 2019."
