H482-ARN-60 [v.4] Page 1 of 2 Amends Title [NO] ,2015 Third Edition Representative Hager moves to amend the bill on page 3, lines 19-41, by rewriting those lines to read: "§ 143-764. Determination of independent contractor status. The following factors shall be considered in determining whether an individual is an independent contractor for purposes of this Article: <u>(1)</u> Whether the individual is engaged in an independent business, calling, or occupation. Whether the individual is to have the independent use of his or her special (2) skill, knowledge, or training in the execution of the work. Whether the individual is doing a specified piece of work at a fixed price or (3) for a lump sum or upon a quantitative basis. (4) Whether the individual is not subject to discharge because he or she adopts one method of doing the work rather than another. Whether the individual is not in the regular employ of the other contracting (5) Whether the individual is free to use such assistants as he or she may think (6) proper. Whether the individual has full control over such assistants. <u>(7)</u> Whether the individual selects his or her own time, subject to customer (8) requirements. (9) Whether the individual has a substantial investment in any equipment or tools required to perform the contracted work. Whether the individual has the opportunity for profit or loss. (b) The presence of one or more of the foregoing factors is not controlling, nor is the
