1 moves to amend the bill on page 27, lines 14-15, by inserting the following between those  
2 lines:

5 "SECTION 47.3.(a) G.S. 86A-3 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 86A-3. Qualifications for certificate as a registered barber.

7 A certificate of registration as a registered barber shall be issued by the Board to any person  
8 who meets all of the following qualifications:

- 9 (1) Has attended an approved barber school for at least 1528 hours.
- 10 (2) Has completed a 12-month apprenticeship under the supervision of a  
11 licensed barber, as provided in G.S. 86A-24.
- 12 (3) Has passed a clinical examination conducted by the Board.
- 13 (4) Has submitted to the Board the affidavit required by G.S. 86A-24(c)  
14 certifying that the applicant has served the apprenticeship required by  
15 subdivision (2).
- 16 (5) Has graduated from high school or has attained an adult high school  
17 equivalency diploma."

18 SECTION 47.3.(b) G.S. 86A-22 reads as rewritten:

19 "§ 86A-22. Licensing and regulating barber schools and colleges.

20 The North Carolina State Board of Barber Examiners may approve barber schools or  
21 colleges in the State, and may prescribe rules and regulations for their operation. The Board  
22 shall adopt rules establishing criteria for barber schools and colleges to maintain their  
23 accreditation. No barber school or college shall be approved by the Board unless the school or  
24 college meets all of the following requirements:

- 25 (1) Each school shall provide a course of instruction of at least 1528 hours.
- 26 (2) Each school shall employ at least two instructors for the first 40 enrolled  
27 students and employ at least one additional instructor for every additional 20  
28 enrolled students. Schools that are organized as nonprofits and have obtained  
29 a ruling from the Internal Revenue Service recognizing their tax-exempt  
30 status shall have at least one instructor for every 20 enrolled students. No  
31 school, whether for profit or nonprofit, shall provide practical training and  
32 theoretical training simultaneously unless at least two instructors are present.
