12	(10)	To operate, own, lease, control, regulate, or grant to others, for a period not to
13		exceed $\frac{25-50}{25-50}$ years, the right to operate on any airport premises restaurants,
14		snack bars, vending machines, food and beverage dispensing outlets, rental car
15		services, catering services, novelty shops, insurance sales, advertising media,
16		merchandising outlets, motels, hotels, barber shops, automobile parking and
17		storage facilities, automobile service establishments, and all other types of
18		facilities as may be directly or indirectly related to the maintenance and
19		furnishing to the general public of a complete air terminal installation.
20	(11)	To contract with persons, firms, or corporations for terms not to exceed 25-50
21		years, for the operation of airline-scheduled passenger and freight flights,
22		nonscheduled flights, and any other airplane activities not inconsistent with the
23		grant agreements under which the airport property is held.
24	(12)	To erect and construct buildings, hangars, shops, and other improvements and
25		facilities, not inconsistent with or in violation of the agreements applicable to
26		and the grants under which the real property of the airport is held; to lease these
27		improvements and facilities for a term or terms not to exceed 25-50 years; to
28		borrow money for use in making and paying for these improvements and
29		facilities, secured by and on the credit only of the lease agreements in respect to
30		these improvements and facilities, and to pledge and assign the leases and lease
31		agreements as security for the authorized loans.
