moves to amend the bill on page 23, line 25, through page 24, line 29, by rewriting those lines to read:

"ELIMINATE AUTHORIZATION FOR VIRTUAL CHARTER SCHOOLS

SECTION 8.13.(a) Section 8.35 of S.L. 2014-100 is repealed.

SECTION 8.13.(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Instruction by S.L. 2015-241 for the 2016-2017 fiscal year to provide funding to the ADM Contingency Reserve to offset the potential costs associated with two virtual charter schools shall be reduced by two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) in recurring funds for the 2016-2017 fiscal year.

SECTION 8.13.(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Instruction by this act for the 2016-2017 fiscal year to support Communities in Schools, which partners with local school administrative units to address the needs of at-risk students, shall be (i) reduced by two million four hundred forty-six thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$2,446,750) in nonrecurring funds for the 2016-2017 fiscal year and (ii) increased by two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) in recurring funds for the 2016-2017 fiscal year.

SECTION 8.13.(d) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Instruction by this act for the 2016-2017 fiscal year for textbooks and digital materials shall be increased by two million four hundred forty-six thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$2,446,750) in nonrecurring funds for the 2016-2017 fiscal year."
