"accomplished" level as part of the North Carolina Teacher 13 Evaluation System and have met expectations as part of student 14 15 growth in the field of licensure sought by the student. For clinical educators employed at Department of Defense 16 <u>2.</u> Elementary and Secondary Schools located in North Carolina 17 and established pursuant to 10 U.S.C. § 2164, have been rated as 18 "fully successful" in all areas of the Department of Defense 19 Education Activity (DoDEA) teacher evaluation instrument. The 20 21 clinical educator shall have met expectations as part of student 22 growth in the field of licensure sought by the student if such student growth measure exists." 23 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 24 25 2017 fall academic semester.
