Short Title: Improve Security/Upper Level/Pking Lot 65. (Public) Representatives Arp, Dollar, Saine, and Lewis (Primary Sponsors). Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ALLOCATE THE UPPER LEVEL OF STATE PARKING DECK 65 TO THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES COMMISSION AND TO AUTHORIZE A FEE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL LIGHTING AND SECURITY TO THE PARKING DECK. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 120-32.1 reads as rewritten: "§ 120-32.1. Use and maintenance of buildings and grounds. The Legislative Services Commission shall: (a) Establish policy for the use of the State legislative buildings and (1) grounds; grounds. (2) Maintain and care for the State legislative buildings and grounds, but the Commission may delegate the actual work of the maintenance of those buildings and grounds to the Department of Administration, which shall perform the work as delegated; delegated. Provide security for the State legislative buildings and grounds; grounds. (3) Allocate space within the State legislative buildings and grounds: (4) and grounds. Have the exclusive authority to assign parking space in the State legislative (5) buildings and grounds. Have the authority to charge a fee of up to five dollars (\$5.00) per month for (6) parking spaces located in the upper level of State Parking Deck 65. This fee is in addition to any existing parking fee and shall be used to provide additional lighting and security features for the parking deck. The authority to charge the fee only applies when the General Assembly is in regular session. For the purposes of this section, the term "State legislative buildings and grounds" (d) means: (1) At all times: The State Legislative Building; Building. a.
