A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO US UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 15A-300.1 reads as rewritten: "§ 15A-300.1. Restrictions on use of unmanned aircraft systems.	
(c) Law Enforcement Exceptions. – Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (b) this section, the use of unmanned aircraft systems by law enforcement agencies of the State of political subdivision of the State is not prohibited in the following instances: (1) To counter a high risk of a terrorist attack by a specific individual organization if the United States Secretary of Homeland Security or the Secretary of the North Carolina Department of Public Safety determines the credible intelligence indicates that such a risk exists. (2) To conduct surveillance in an area that is within a law enforcement office plain view when the officer is in a location the officer has a legal right to be a lift the law enforcement agency first obtains a search warrant authorizing the use of an unmanned aircraft system. (4) If the law enforcement agency possesses reasonable suspicion that, under particular circumstances, swift action is needed to prevent imminent dangent to life or serious damage to property, to forestall the imminent escape of suspect or the destruction of evidence, to conduct pursuit of an escapeer suspect, or to facilitate the search for a missing person. (b) of this section, an emergency management agency, as defined in G.S. 166A-19.3, may unmanned aircraft systems for all functions and activities related to emergency manageme including incident command, area reconnaissance, search and rescue, preliminary dama assessment, hazard risk management, and floodplain mapping.	use ent,
