1 moves to amend the bill on page 158, lines 13 and 14, by inserting between those lines a new  
2 section to read:  
3 **"NC STATE-RECOGNIZED TRIBES FUNDING**  
4 **SECTION 11C.16.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act to the contrary,  
5 recurring funds appropriated to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of  
6 Social Services (Division), in each year of the 2017-2019 fiscal biennium for North Carolina  
7 State-recognized tribes shall be used by the Division, in collaboration with the North Carolina  
8 State Commission on Indian Affairs within the Department of Administration, to assist in (i)  
9 recruiting foster parents, (ii) increasing the number of foster homes for children who are  
10 members of a North Carolina State-recognized tribe, and (iii) providing training for staff of  
11 county departments of social services to ensure culturally appropriate services for children who  
12 are members of a North Carolina State-recognized tribe."
