3 "NC STATE-RECOGNIZED TRIBES FUNDING

4 SECTION 11C.16. Notwithstanding any other provision of this act to the contrary, 5 recurring funds appropriated to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Social Services (Division), in each year of the 2017-2019 fiscal biennium for North Carolina 6 7 State-recognized tribes shall be used by the Division, in collaboration with the North Carolina State Commission on Indian Affairs within the Department of Administration, to assist in (i) 8 9 recruiting foster parents, (ii) increasing the number of foster homes for children who are members of a North Carolina State-recognized tribe, and (iii) providing training for staff of 10 county departments of social services to ensure culturally appropriate services for children who 11 12 are members of a North Carolina State-recognized tribe.".
