Senator Krawiec

1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 21-22, by rewriting those lines to read:

- 2
- 3 "(3) For the purposes of this subsection, a person shall be considered to be deaf
- 4 or hard of hearing if they provide verification or documentation
- 5 substantiating their hearing loss that is recommended by the Division of
- 6 Services for the Deaf and the Hard of Hearing as acceptable. The Division of
- 7 Motor Vehicles shall consult with the Division of Services for the Deaf and
- 8 the Hard of Hearing to identify acceptable forms of verification that do not
- 9 result in undue burden to the person requesting the designation of hearing
- 10 loss. Acceptable documentation shall include any of the following:
- 11 a. Documentation of certification or examination by a medical, health,
- 12 or audiology professional showing evidence of hearing loss.
- 13 b. Affidavit executed by the person, their parent, or guardian attesting
- 14 to the person's hearing loss.
- 15 c. Documentation deemed by the Division of Motor Vehicles to qualify
- 16 as satisfactory proof of the person's hearing loss."
