SECTION 4.(a) Section 2.2 of the Charter of the Town of Orrum, being Chapter 993 of the 1983 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 2.2. Town Council; Composition; Terms of Office. The Town Council shall be composed of 4 members, each of whom shall be elected for a term of 2 years four years in the manner provided by Article III of this Charter, provided they shall serve until their successors are elected and qualified."

SECTION 4.(b) Section 2.3 of the Charter of the Town of Orrum, being Chapter 993 of the 1983 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 2.3. Mayor; Term of Office; Duties. The Mayor shall be elected in the manner provided by Article II of this Charter to serve for a term of 2 years four years or until his the mayor's successor is elected and qualified. The Mayor shall be the official head of the Town government and shall preside at all meetings of the Council. He-The mayor shall have the right to vote in any and all matters before the Council. The Mayor shall exercise such powers and perform such duties as presently are or hereinafter may be conferred upon him the mayor by the General Statutes of North Carolina, by this Charter, and by the ordinances of the Town."

SECTION 4.(c) Section 3.1 of the Charter of the Town of Orrum, being Chapter 993 of the 1983 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3.1.; Regular Municipal Elections; Conduct and Method of Election. Regular municipal elections shall be held in the Town every 2 years four years and shall be conducted in accordance with the uniform municipal election laws of North Carolina. The Mayor and
