- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 4
- 2 by rewriting that line to read:
- 3 "ARE OFFERED FOR CONSUMPTION FREE OF CHARGE AND TO AUTHORIZE
- 4 CERTAIN SMALL MUNICIPALITIES WITH DECREASING POPULATIONS TO
- 5 ATTRACT BUSINESS THROUGH A MALT BEVERAGE AND UNFORTIFIED WINE
- 6 ELECTION, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNING BOARD.";
- 7
- 8 And on page 3, lines 3-4
- 9 By inserting the following between those lines:
- 10 "SECTION 2.5. G.S. 18B-600(c) reads as rewritten:
- 11 "(c) City Malt Beverage and Unfortified Wine Elections. – A city may hold a malt
- 12 beverage or unfortified wine election only if the county in which the city is located has already
- 13 held such an election, the vote in the last county election was against the sale of that kind of
- 14 alcoholic beverage, ~~and~~ and one or more of the following apply:
- 15 (1) The city has a population of 500 or ~~more~~; or more according to the most
- 16 recent federal decennial census.
- 17 (2) The city operates an ABC store.
- 18 (3) The city has a population of 400 or more but less than 500 according to the
- 19 most recent federal decennial census and had a population of 500 or more
- 20 according to the prior federal decennial census.";
- 21
- 22 And on page 3, line 7
- 23 By rewriting that line to read:
- 24 "SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective August 1, 2017. The
- 25 remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law."
